
Unlike traditional certifications or degrees, a digital credential gives a potential employer, client or colleague the ability to instantly see what you had to do to earn it, what coursework it covered and what it qualifies you to do, simply by clicking on your credential. It also provides secure verification so the viewer can confirm that you did in fact earn it.


After setting up the account and accepting the credential, you are now ready to share with your achievements with your social media network.

Your credential will appear under the **EARNED** tab. Click on the badge to view details about your credential.



STEP 3:

Hover your mouse over the image to **MANAGE** setting and access **SHARING TOOLS**. By clicking on the individual social media links, you will share the credential image and details via your "newsfeed."

When you tweet or post the image, viewers who click on the badge will be led to ELI's **digital credential verification** page with details on your achievements.





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STFP 4:

Viewers will see a brief overview on the course(s) you've taken, or they may also click **VIEW EVIDENCE** to see the full course syllabus.

Digital Credential Verification

Digital Credentials, also known as Open Badges, are the newest way for professionals to share their achievements and skills. When a recipient chooses to share their credential, anyone who views it may click on it and be brought to a customized, individual verification page, like this one, which confirms who the credential was issued to, when it was issues, what was involved in earning it, and other useful data.
