- Hateful or highly offensive content, including personal insults or content that attacks or dehumanizes a person based on gender, gender identity, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, religion, or political affiliation
- Profanity
- Spam
- Misleading, fraudulent, or deceptive content
- Illegal content or activities
